Protein: Crude protein makes up %85 of the bully stick. It supports muscle development, tissue repair, immune health, and a shiny coat.

Amino Acids: Bully sticks contain essential amino acids required for protein synthesis, cognitive function, healing, and healthy skin.

Omega-3 Fatty Acids: Present due to grass-fed beef sourcing.

These support anti-inflammatory processes, healthy joints, skin, and coat.

Minerals (Ash): Roughly %10 ash content includes calcium, phosphorus, magnesium, vital for bones, teeth, and muscle function.

Fat: Low-fat content (~%3–2) helps maintain healthy weight while aiding vitamin absorption and energy.

Fiber & Moisture: Fiber (~%3-2) supports digestion; low moisture keeps chews firm for longer dental engagement.

Calories: Approximately 15 kcal/inch or ~3 kcal/g. Helps monitor treat portions to maintain healthy daily caloric intake.
